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Auditor General highlights strategies to make significant impact

VICTORIA – Auditor General Carol Bellringer has released the Office of the Auditor General of British Columbia’s 2018/19 Service Plan, outlining the goals and strategies for the coming fiscal year, and how the office will measure its progress.

“This is our story of how we’re making a difference in B.C. and how we proudly serve the broader public interest,” said Bellringer. “This plan is a part of our overall performance management framework which includes our annual report, strategic plan and audit plans.”

The service plan enables the office to reaffirm its purpose, goals, objectives and performance measures. This year’s plan continues to track the new range of KPIs and more meaningful measurements introduced over the last two years.

The Office of the Auditor General produces the annual audit opinion on government’s financial statements, and performance audits that speak to the efficiency and effectiveness of government’s programs. The office’s performance audit and financial audit coverage plans identify the work it intends to start over the next three years. This fall, the office will release updated coverage plans.
