## **Auditor General announces strategy for the coming year**

VICTORIA – Auditor General Carol Bellringer released her office’s 2016-17 Service Plan, outlining goals and strategies for the coming fiscal year and how her office will measure its progress.

“The Service Plan provides strong direction for our office,” Bellringer said. “It sets out what we’re doing and how we’re evaluating ourselves.”

The Office of the Auditor General mainly produces audit opinions on government’s financial statements and performance audits that speak to the efficiency and effectiveness of government’s programs. The office’s performance audit and financial audit coverage plans identify the work it intends to start over the next three years. Both coverage plans are available on the office’s website.
